Types of courses that we teach and associated effort:

Academic course, large ensemble (3-6 hrs/week) = 20%
Pedagogy, literature, repertoire, or diction course, small ensemble (2- 4 hrs/week) = 7.5%
Applied instruction (1 hr weekly lesson, advising and prep) = 2.5%
Studio master class (1 hr weekly) = 2.5%
Chamber music coaching (1-2 hrs weekly) = 2.5%

Teaching assignments will take into consideration the time spent on both preparation and instruction, with an understanding that teaching workloads might translate to different course loads based on the cumulative preparation required. Faculty teaching for an entire academic year may not always have an equal load for both semesters; the total will, however, be consistent with these guidelines.

## **Teaching/Clinical faculty**

60-80% of appointment generally dedicated to teaching, 0-20% to research, 20% to service Sample workload for a semester:

Some course assignments may include supervision of graduate teaching assistants and mentoring of students through office hours and other activities.

Chamber music coaching (3 groups weekly @ 2.5% each): 7.5%

Teaching-related research (e.g., performances representing UI): 10%

Service (e.g., recruitment activities, including auditions and college fairs, faculty meetings, curriculum revision, committees as assigned): 20%

### Lecturer/Instructor

80% of appointment generally dedicated to teaching, 20% to service:

# Research faculty

80% of appointment generally dedicated to research, 20% to service.
