

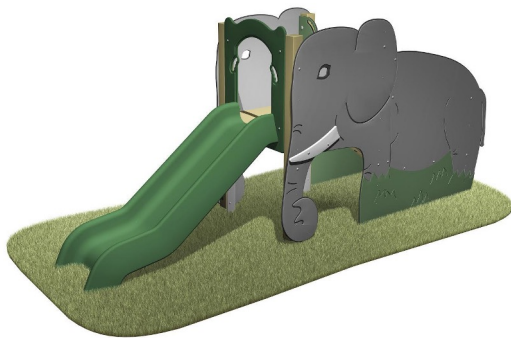

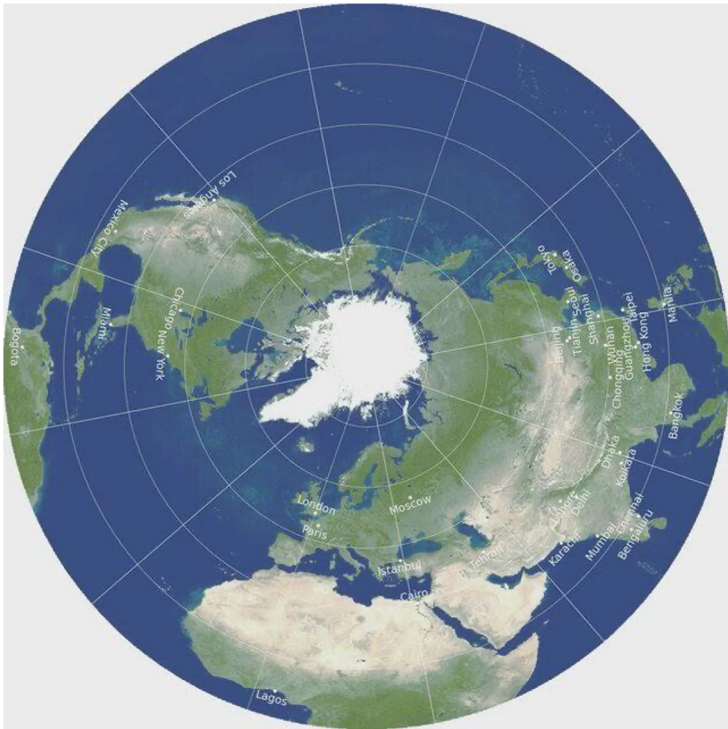

Research/Idea process: (THEME)

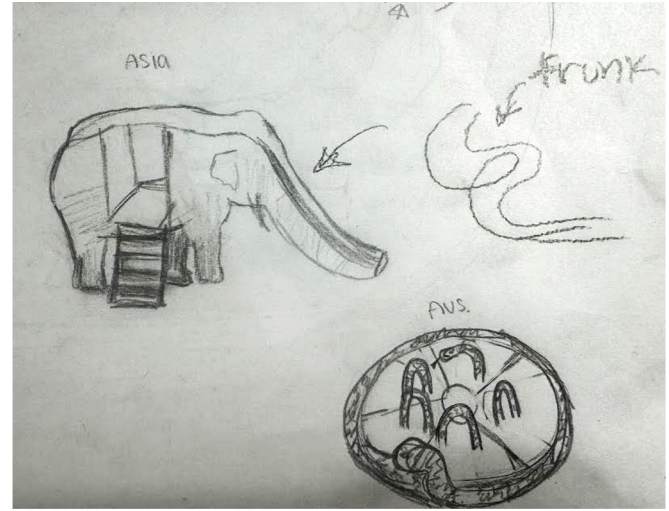
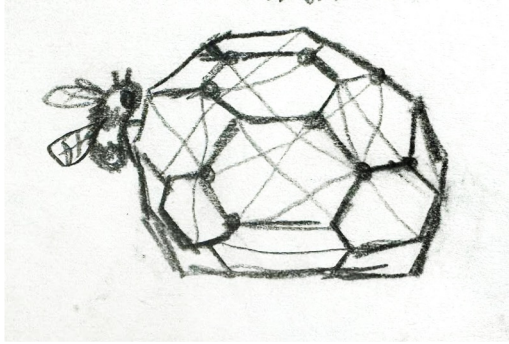

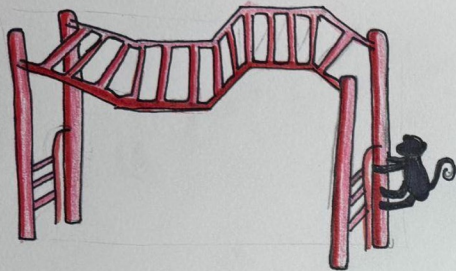
- North America = bumble bee

Research/Idea process: (LAYOUT)

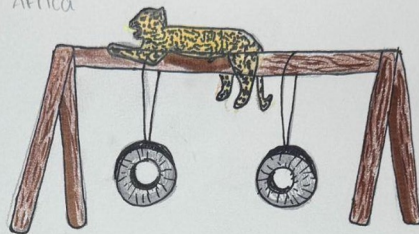
