The College of Fine & Applied Arts is looking for student design intern(s)! We seek one or more creative problem-solvers that are self-motivated and resourceful graphic design students. Interns will have the opportunity to be a part of a fun, energetic, creative team and gain experience in a professional environment. Student designers will create innovative and strategic visuals for the college and its eight academic and three nonacademic units while building an impressive portfolio. Ideal candidates will have a good understanding of Adobe InDesign, Illustrator, and Photoshop. Additionally, candidates should be well-versed in design basics and capable of generating multiple concepts for a given prompt. Previous graphic design work experience is a plus but not required. This position will be primarily remote, so candidates should be detail oriented and have strong communication and organizational skills. The schedule for this position is flexible but does require a commitment of 2–8 hours per week. It is necessary that interns be reliable and capable of meeting deadlines. The student internships are paid positions and are not eligible for course credit.
