- ARCH 595IN - - Integrated Design and Construction of Buildings (Prof. Aminmansour)
- ARCH 574 - - Design: Architecture and Urban Design (Design of Tall Buildings section only - - Professor Armstrong)

Graduate students in either MArch, MS in AS, or any joint degree program offered by the School of Architecture may apply to enroll in this program.
